

Samsung S21 Ultra 5G: 3 Weeks Later with the “Bat Mobile”



We had the Samsung S21 Ultra 5G for 3 weeks and concluded how this device is an Ultra among its other siblings, the Samsung S21 5G and S21+ 5G. As a content creator, choosing the right device is critical for work. 3 weeks was barely enough to give a better perspective over this mobile device.

In short, this device is all about the camera. Its built with 4 cameras. The main sensor is a new generation 108MP primary camera, with 12MP ultra-wide-angle camera and two 10MP telephoto cameras with different focal length complete the setup. The front camera is 40MP and its more than enough for selfies and wefies.

Yes the main highlight of the Samsung S21 Ultra 5G is the camera but who is it for? Let's find out!

Under the Hood Overview

BATTERY

Packed with a bigger **5000mAh** compared to its siblings, the S21+ and S21. This made the device work for a whole day in high performance work.

STORAGE

Starts with 128GB, 256GB and 512 GB storage. The one we tested had **256GB storage**.

CAMERA

At the back it has 4 cameras. Wide, Ultrawide and two telephoto cameras with different focal length as mentioned earlier. The focus is now laser autofocus, replacing TOF (time-of-flight) sensor for focus. The **108MP** wide camera has amazing autofocus and its enhanced with focus enhancer tool which will find focus on a subject faster.

PRICE

Starting at **RM 5299.00**. Priced exactly as an iPhone 12 Pro Max but with higher storage.

PROCESSOR RAM

The heart of the phone is a **Snapdragon 888 chip with 12 GB Ram**. The highest spec comes with 16GB Ram.

INFRA

5G on this phone is still not widely used here but the call and data quality over 4G and wifi was nothing to complaint about.

Look and Feel

The phone was finished in phantom black and in my opinion, it really looked stealthy. Like a mobile device that batman uses, or we can call it “bat mobile”. The Samsung S21 Ultra 5G is an uncompromising device.

Its a Touchscreen Bar Form Factor with a 6.8” Display but really a 6.6” with rounded corners. The screen is impressive with WQHD (Wide Quad HD) resolution with refresh rate up to 120Hz. Unlike the Samsung S20 Ultra, the display can run on WQHD resolution and still do 120Hz refresh rate. The phone is covered with Corning's Gorilla Glass Victus. The screen is very bright and crisp with dense 551 ppi along with an ultrasonic fingerprint reader on the screen.



It weighs 227g which means its a heavy device compared to many other mobile devices, but its not a bad thing as it feels pretty solid in your grip. The camera bulge with 4 cameras at the back is not obvious with curved design but it will not lay flat on a table. The buttons volume and power button were sturdy and reminds us its a flagship phone.
